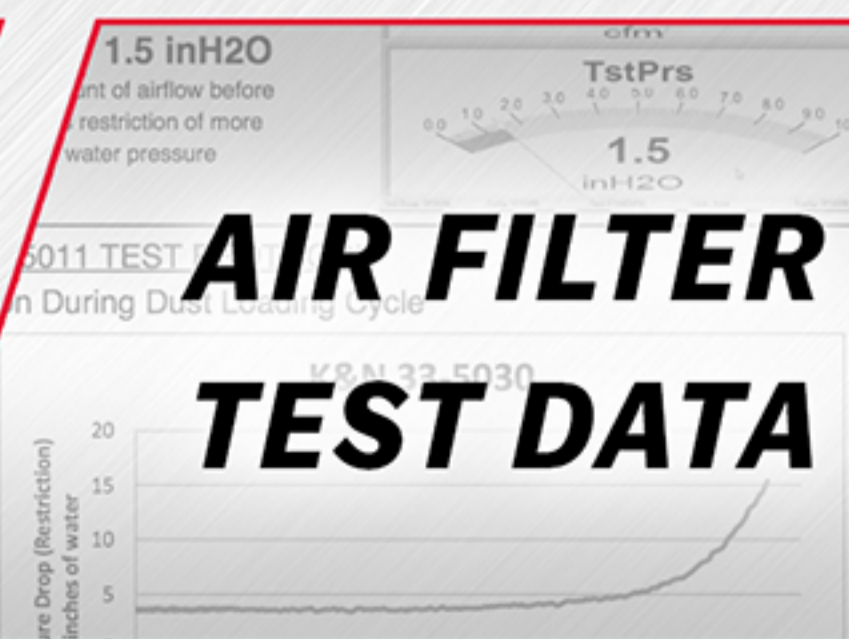

NEWS STORY

At Colorado and its mechanical test the GMC Canyon were first introduced in placement for the aging Chevy S-10 and GMC Sonoma pickup trucks. Initial Canyon sales were high, surpassing that of the one-time best-selling Ford F-150. Many factors led to a slump in mid-size pickup sales for all the major players leading Chevy, Ford, and Dodge to pull out of the mid-size truck market. The first generation Colorado and Canyon ended in 2012, however a new truck continued to be sold in markets outside of North America. After a absence from the United States the Chevy Colorado and GMC Canyon has returned.

The standard engine for 2015 Chevy Colorado and GMC Canyon is a 2.5L Ecotec I4 engine. The 2011 Chevy Malibu and the Cadillac ATS. The 2.5L Ecotec I4 engine is rated at 200 horsepower, is a far less powerful engine than the 3.6L I4 engine found in the 2015 Chevy Colorado and GMC Canyon. Equally impressive is the 3.6-liter I4 engine found in the 2015 Chevy Colorado and GMC Canyon. The 305-horsepower optional V6 engine makes the 2015 Colorado and 2015 Canyon the most powerful mid-size pickup trucks available in the North American market.
